## Update from Preserve and Protect Contributed by Anna Zinkhon

Preserve and Protect Camp Springs is still fighting the Forced Main Sewer Pipe. What's **new** is that we are organizing the clean-up and protection of the Four Mile watershed. Four Mile Creek has been an impaired waterway for many years. There is a warning not to swim or eat fish from this creek. Our group has begun organizing the steps by which many property owners can get assistance in correcting the years and years of pollution caused by erosion and other sources. This is a long-term project with many groups involved, including KY Division of Water, KY Transportation, NKU Environmental Science Program, Campbell County Conservation District, UK Extension, City of Alexandria, City of Silver Grove, Campbell County Planning and Zoning, and ORSANCO.
