One of the things that they like most about life in Camp Springs is the rural life with echoes of the farm Ray grew up on; but at the same time, Camp Springs residents have easy access to a large city, to good hospitals and entertainment options. Ray says, "It's almost like a secret, this county peacefulness only fifteen minutes from the city."

Gerri shared a memory of her softball team stopping at Sandfoss's grocery for Chocola on the way to the ball field for a game, and stopping there again on the way home for a snack. That ball field was a special place, and also where Gerri made her famous triple play.

Both Ray and Gerri are and have been active with St. Joseph Church and with the Fire Department. Gerri was the school secretary at St. Joseph for thirty-one years and is a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Fire Department. Ray serves on the church's parish council and has worked with the EMS squad and as a fireman for the Camp Springs Fire Dept.

While their fond memories of Camp Springs recall the close knit community where everyone knew everyone, their dreams for the future of Camp Springs include horse-drawn tours of the area and more attention being paid to the history of Camp Springs and the lives of its earliest residents.

Ray and Gerri's favorite place in Camp Springs is St. Joseph Church, where so many of their important life events have taken place. "The best place to be," says Gerri, "is at the church looking up at the sky and at the view of the valley."
