Library Express Serves Camp Springs

A convenient, new service of the Campbell County Public Library has been providing materials to residents of the Camp Springs community since May 2017. At Library Express locations in Silver Grove and Melbourne patrons can retrieve and return items from any Campbell County library.

The Silver Grove Library Express is located at the firehouse in Silver Grove and the Melbourne facility can be found at the St. Philip Parish Center in Melbourne. Items are checked out in the normal way through the library website, app or by calling one of the branches. If a Library Express location is given as the pick-up point, the patron will be notified when the item has been delivered, and it can then be picked up by entering the last five digits of the patron's library card number at the appropriate Library Express site.

The Library Express locations are lit at night and are accessible twenty-four hours a day and seven days a week. Please encourage your families to take advantage of this service.

Bread of Life Food Pantry Welcomes Clients at St. John Lutheran

The Bread of Life Food Pantry operates on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month from 1-3 p.m. from the basement of St. John Lutheran Church at 5977 Lower Tug Fork Road in Camp Springs. Clients who meet USDA income regulations, which are available at <http://www.nkadd.org/individuals/housing-food/commodities-program>, have access to the USDA-provided foodstuffs once a month. In addition to the boxes of food packed according to USDA guidelines, clients are welcomed to the Selection Room. There they can choose a stipulated number of items as they would in a supermarket. The items in the Selection Room are provided free of charge, and are donated by area schools, churches and individuals or purchased by the food pantry from monetary donations.

The pantry is staffed and run by volunteers from St. John and St. Luke Lutheran churches and other community members.
