November 17, 2008
MINUTES

The monthly meeting of the Camp Springs Initiative was held November 17, 2008 at St. John Lutheran. Attending were Carolyn Allender, Lonnie Enzweiler, Nancy Enzweiler, Phillip Garber, Chuck Heilman, Don Wiedeman and Anna Zinkhon.

Minutes of the last meeting (October 2008) were read and accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Balance is \$353.71. Carolyn has a donation from Camp Springs Day to add to the treasury.

Old Business: Signs will be decorated with trees and ribbons. Chuck will provide trees and set up by December 1. Carolyn and Anna will decorate the trees.

New Business: Election of Officers. Phillip Garber made a motion, seconded by Anna Zinkhon to reelect the officers by acclamation. The motion passed. Officers are Carolyn Allender, President; Chuck Heilman, Vice-President; Nancy Enzweiler, Secretary; Lonnie Enzweiler, Treasurer. The Officers will meet at 7 p.m. on December 15 at Nancy Enzweiler's house.

Committee Reports:

Trails: The Committee is considering a trailhead layout and will be contacting Dallas Bray. Anna Zinkhon reported that Bridle Tag holders will sign a release form and be informed of trail regulations.

Chuck discussed the possibility of a walking trail under existing power lines. The Campbell County Conservation District would be the lease holder.

Chuck's call about the possibility of trails following the path of the proposed water line was not returned

Herbst Tour: Next year's tour will be October 18 from 12-6. Don Wiedeman is planning to produce a small brochure to provide year-round promotion of the tour.

Historic Homes: November meeting was cancelled due to lack of interest

Public Education and Outreach: A December issue of the *Camp Springs News* will be distributed to churches and businesses by Dec. 1.

Preservation of Agricultural Heritage: Anna Zinkhon proposed community quilt nights at Misty Ridge in January and February. A program for prospective wine growers through the extension service was proposed. Lonnie Enzweiler will look into this.

Other Business: Truck traffic on 4-Mile was discussed. Don Wiedeman will talk to the Highway Department.

Carolyn will inquire about using stone from the Doring place for stonework around the Camp Springs sign.
