1st Annual CSI Photo Contest

This year's Camp Springs Day will feature a photography contest for the first time. Mark your calendar now for Camp Springs Day at StoneBrook Winery on August 29 and read on for the photography contest rules.

ELIGIBILITY

There are three divisions: adult, high school (grades 9 -12), and elementary/middle school (grades 1-8). Contestants must be Camp Springs residents and amateur photographers.

RULES

Only three entries per person (must be three different classes). Copy machine or computer generated photos will not be accepted. Digital and film prints, color or black & white prints are acceptable. Size of photo must be no larger than 8" x10". All photos must be mounted on a mat board. Photos under glass and/or in frames will not be accepted.

CLASSES

1. Camp Springs Life (Festivals, Events etc)
2. Scenic/Nature
3. Pets and Animals
4. Historic Camp Springs

PHOTO ENTRY IDENTIFICATION

All entries must be labeled on the back of the photo:

1. Contestant's name
2. Division: adult, high school (grades 9-12), or elementary/middle school (grades 1-8)
3. Address & telephone number
4. Class entered (If no class specified, the judges will decide.)
5. Title of photograph
6. Name of photographer may not be on the front.

JUDGING

Judging will take place the week of August 24. Photographs will be on exhibit Saturday, August 29. Members of the Tri-State Photographic Society will participate in the judging.

PRIZES

First, second, and third place ribbons will be awarded in each class and division. Best of Show ribbon will be awarded to one of the four first-place winners. People's Choice ribbon will be awarded to photo chosen from votes of visiting public.

TO ENTER CONTEST

No contest entry fee. Entries can be hand-delivered or mailed. Mail entries to: Contest, c/o Don Wiedeman, 7742 Stonehouse Road, Camp Springs, KY, 41059.

Hand delivered entries can be dropped off at the StoneBrook Winery 6570 Vineyard Lane, Camp Springs, or above address August 22 & 23. 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. **All entries must be received by August 23. Late entries will not be judged.**

YOUR ENTRIES RETURNED

Entries may be removed from the display on Camp Springs Day, August 29, at 8 p.m.. Entries will be available for pickup at StoneBrook Winery, Sunday, August 30 from 1-4 p.m. Enclose a self-addressed and stamped envelope for entries to be returned by mail. Be certain to check postage with your local post office.

PUBLICATION

Winners will be announced on the Camp Springs Website (www.campsprings.com), and Northern Kentucky News (www.nky.com). Best of Show winner may be shown in the 2010 Camp Springs Calendar depending on content and quality.
