Camp Springs Church Hosts Food Pantry

For over six years, volunteers from St. John (Camp Springs) and St. Luke (Cold Spring) Lutheran churches have been gathering to distribute food to their fellow Campbell County residents. Bread of Life Food Pantry, located at St. John Lutheran Church, distributes food to county residents who meet current USDA income guidelines. Clients of the food pantry are also welcome to choose from supplemental food, hygiene and paper products that the pantry is able to stock through donations from individuals and organizations. Local groups who have contributed to the food pantry's supplemental shelves include Silver Grove Schools and the Catholic Order of Foresters at St. Joseph Catholic Church.

Bread of Life Food Pantry welcomes clients year round on the first and third Monday of each month from 2-4 p.m. If a federal holiday falls on a scheduled Monday, the pantry is open the next day from 2-4 p.m. Clients are eligible to receive one family-sized box of federal commodity food items per month. *For more information, please call 635-5013.*
