Four Mile Road Safety Update

The following update on safety measures being implemented on Four Mile Road was provided in July by Geoff Besecker.

- 1. SR 547 will be painted with no passing throughout when the painting crew makes their rounds (between now and September)
- 2. The state will install "Congested Area" signs at the curves near Greskamp Rd.
- 3. KYTC District 06 office is still waiting for the results of the classification count study.
- 4. The County will be taking up the issue on Greskamp Rd. in the following ways. 1) Making the intersection of Greskamp and the road to St. Joseph a 3-way stop via ordinance. The first ordinance reading was on July 17, the second and the vote will be on August 7. Once the stop signs are up, enhanced enforcement will begin. 2) Targeted speed enforcement of SR 547 will be implemented once the speed limit signs have been up for a while.

CSI will meet on September 9 at 7 p.m. at the Camp Springs Winery to discuss this and other community issues.
