Camp Springs Initiative (CSI) Tackles Four-Mile Truck Traffic

Members of CSI and other community residents met on November 13th to discuss concerns related to truck traffic and safety on Four Mile Road. County Commissioner Geoff Besecker was also invited to attend, and he agreed to communicate the community's concerns to the appropriate agencies. At the meeting, a letter with photographic evidence of safety issues on the road was approved to be sent to Kentucky's Office of Claims and Appeals and the Secretary of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. The following ideas were also discussed.

- Eliminating through traffic of semis on Four Mile
- Prohibiting the use of Jake brakes
- Limiting truck weight
- Posting school zone signs and lights at St. Joseph
- Using cameras and/or speed monitors
- Lowering the speed limit to 35 mph from Alexandria to Silver Grove

CSI will meet again on March 4 at 7 p.m. at the Camp Springs Vineyard and invites all interested community members to attend.
